# A COMPLETE SYSTEM OF GLASS CLEANING PRODUCTS

## GLASS MICROFIBER WASHER

Engineered for performance, the Glass Microfiber Washer combines superior absorbency with durable construction for fewer trips to your bucket and more time cleaning. Designed to withstand repeated use, it helps professionals clean efficiently job after job, with an integrated edge scrubber to tackle stubborn dirt in hard-to-reach areas.



## GLASS SQUEEGEE

The Glass Squeegee delivers streak-free results with every pass. Featuring a soft rubber blade that glides effortlessly over glass, ensuring a spotless, professional finish on the first try.



## GLASS CLEANING BUCKET AND LID

Bucket fits 18-inch Microfiber Washer and Squeegee for easy cleaning of large surfaces, and has volume indicator graduated fill lines for a precise fill every time.



## 4 INCH GLASS SCRAPER

Angled scraper helps remove sticky residue, like stickers, tape, or paint splatter, in hard-to-reach areas.



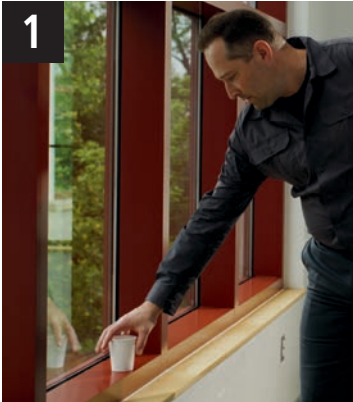
## GLASS MICROFIBER CLOTH

# PREP FOR PERFORMANCE SET THE STAGE FOR A STREAK-FREE SHINE

## PREP



**REMOVE** obstacles and clear large debris from the working area.



**PREPARE** cleaning solution by adding the cleaning agent of your choice into the bucket.



**ADD** water using the graduated fill lines inside the Glass Cleaning Bucket.

# CLEAN WITH CONFIDENCE WASH AWAY DIRT FOR A CLEARER VIEW

## WASH



**DIP** Microfiber Washer into the soapy solution, then wring it out to reach preferred saturation level.



**START** at the top, placing the Washer on the glass.



**USE** even pressure and completely cover the glass in cleaning solution, washing the glass to remove dirt on the surface.



# FINISH STRONG FROM STUCK-ON TO STREAK FREE

## SCRAPE



**REMOVE** protective cover from scraper.  
**USE** Scraper to remove tough grime or stuck-on messes and sticky residue caused by tape or stickers.



**HOLD** at a slight angle and gently press the blade against the surface and glide the Scraper using smooth, even strokes.

## SQUEEGEE AND FINISH



**PIVOT** Squeegee to preferred angle. The Squeegee has two pivot points, vertically (0° and 45°) and horizontally (-45° to 45°), to handle tight angles and tricky glass shapes. The adjustable rotating head locks in any vertical position from 0° to 45° and in any horizontal position from 0° to 180°.



**START** at the top, placing the Squeegee on the glass.  
**KEEP** the Squeegee at a 20° angle to the glass and work in an S-shape from top to bottom



**USE** slightly overlapping strokes to remove liquid from the surface.



**FINISH** by detailing with a HYGEN™ Microfiber Glass Cloth to dry the edges and absorb any remaining water.

# REACH HIGHER CLEAN EVERY INCH WITH CONFIDENCE



**ATTACH** the Microfiber Washer to a Quick-Connect Handle.



**EXTEND** the handle to the length needed for higher windows.  
**SCRUB** the wet surface using the Microfiber Washer.



**USE** the Quick-Connect release buttons to swap the Microfiber Washer with the Squeegee.



**REMOVE** liquid from the surface by making slightly overlapping strokes with the Squeegee.

# MAINTAIN TO PERFORM CLEAN, REFRESH, AND REUSE



**REMOVE** dirt and debris from your Microfiber Washer to ensure it's ready for your next clean.

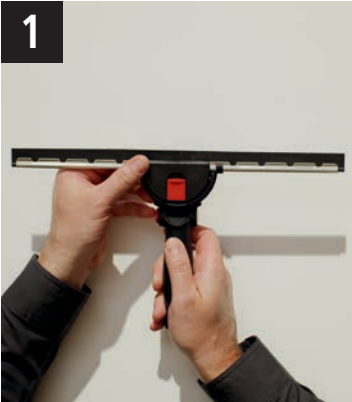


**UNFASTEN** the hook and loop patch and slide the Microfiber Washer Sleeve off the T-bar.



**WASH** in a standard laundry machine for thorough cleaning.  
**DRY** Microfiber Washer Sleeves on low heat (130°F/54°C) setting.  
**DO NOT** use fabric softener or dryer sheets.

# STAY SHARP REPLACE BLADES FOR CONSISTENT CLARITY



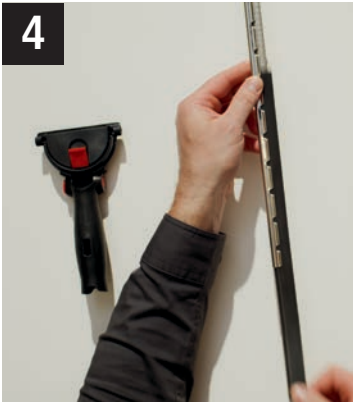
**CHECK** the condition of your Squeegee blade for cracks, rips, or tears.



**REPLACE** by unlocking the latch on the back of the Squeegee.



**REMOVE** the steel channel.



**SLIDE** out the rubber blade and set aside.



**INSERT** the new replacement Squeegee blade into the steel channel and make sure the flat edge is facing outward.  
**ALIGN** the steel channel with the Squeegee handle.




**LOCK** the latch back into place, making sure the teeth on the underside of the latch grip the rubber blade securely.



LAUNDRY GUIDE


THE FOLLOWING STEPS ARE RECOMMENDED TO PROPERLY LAUNDER AND TAKE CARE OF YOUR MICROFIBER:

1.




CLEAN the laundry machines daily and before the first use.

2.



SEPARATE soiled Rubbermaid Microfiber Cloths and Mops from other textiles at the point of contamination.


3.



DETERMINE detergent and maximum load size using chart on the right.\*

For higher level of clean and added layer of assurance, use chlorine bleach, as applicable. Confirm with chemical supplier for correct quantity<sup>1</sup>

Pre-rinse/soak: Mops/cloths may require pre-rinses/soaks to open fibers and loosen soil  
Washing with Cold Water: chlorine bleach is required, refer to measurements in prior step




Water Quality: Soft water (zero grains hardness); low to moderate alkalinity (0–100 ppm @Na2O); no iron in water

COMMERCIAL DRYING

- Dry cloths and mops on low heat (130°F/54°C) setting
- Remove dry textiles from the dryer immediately
- Store dry cloths and mops in clean Rubbermaid Cube Truck



REQUIRED CARE

- Do not store Rubbermaid Cloths or Mops in a washing machine overnight
- Do not use fabric softener
- Do not use dryer sheets

\*Machine settings can be established by chemical provider.  
\*\*Represents 1/2 the average manufacturer's detergent recommendation. Using full amount of detergent can result in hazy floors.
