BEGIN with open, clean Microfiber cloth



CLEAN surfaces with two exposed sides of cloth



OPEN cloth fully once four sides have been used



FOLD Microfiber cloth in half



OPEN Microfiber cloth once to change sides



REPEAT steps 2 through 7 to use all eight sides



FOLD Microfiber cloth in quarters



REFOLD to expose two fresh cleaning sides

TIP ♀

Always track sides being used to prevent cross-contamination

Color is also a visually effective way to prevent cross-contamination.
