

NOTES

- Don all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): glasses, gloves, etc.
- Always dust mop prior to wet mopping to reduce floor hazing.
- Follow all established safety procedures.



CONNECT the Quick-Connect Adjustable Handle to the Quick-Connect Frame by clicking into place.



PLACE clean wet mop or dust mop on floor with logo-imprinted backing facing upward.



ATTACH the Quick-Connect Handle to the Quick-Connect Frame by clicking into place.



ADJUST handle length by loosening the black locking ring and extending or collapsing the handle.



ALIGN the tip of the handle with chin for ideal length. Tighten locking ring before use.

USER PREFERENCE



FIGURE 8 CLEANING Clean floor using Figure 8 strokes. For most cleaning, work with the handle pointed upward for ideal positioning.

USER PREFERENCE



TO REMOVE a mop from the Quick-Connect Frame, grasp the fabric loop and peel the mop away.



PUSH-AND-PULL CLEANING
Point the handle downward.



OR TO REMOVE a mop, step on an exposed edge of the mop, and with the other foot on the opposite edge of the Quick-Connect Frame, lift the handle, peeling the mop away.

18" MICROFIBER FRINGED DUST MOP

NOTES

- Don all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): glasses, gloves, etc.
- Dust mop each room with a clean mop to help prevent cross-transmission.
- Dust mopping helps reduce floor hazing.
- Follow all established safety procedures.



REMOVE large debris from floor, clean any wet spots, and affix the Quick-Connect Handle to the 18" Quick-Connect Frame by



PLACE a clean dust mop on floor with logo-imprinted backing facing upward.



ATTACH the Quick-Connect Handle to the Quick-Connect Frame by clicking into place.



BEGIN dust mopping at the far corner of the room, using overlapping Figure 8 strokes, while moving backward toward the doorway.



STEP-ON METHOD

To remove the mop from the frame, step on an exposed edge of the mop, and with the other foot on the opposite edge of the Quick-Connect Frame, lift the handle, peeling the mop away.



POSITION the Quick-Connect Frame crosswise to the mop, engage the hook-andloop strips and lift.



DEPOSIT soiled mop into the mesh laundry net, using the handle and frame.



REPEAT steps 2 through 7 to correctly dust mop each room.







18" - 60" QUICK-CONNECT FRAMES



18" - 60" MICROFIBER FRINGED DUST MOPS

NOTES

- Don all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): glasses, gloves, etc.
- HYGEN Microfiber Dust Mops trap and lock dust and dirt away with more surface contact, thoroughly dusting floors.
- Follow all established safety procedures.



REMOVE

large debris from floor and make certain any wet spots are dried before dusting with microfiber mops, as the dense microfiber fibers are very absorbent and will "stick" to wet spots, making the mop difficult to push.



SELECT

a mop size that will complete the job in the least number of passes.

NOTE: If a hallway is 60" wide, a 36" mop will clean it in two passes; however a 24" mop will require three passes, taking more time to clean the space.



ATTACH the Quick-Connect Handle to the Quick-Connect Frame by clicking into place.



PLACE

a clean microfiber fringed dust mop on the floor with the logo-imprinted side facing up and press the Quick-Connect Frame onto the mop to attach.



BEGIN

at the end of the hallway or the far corner of the room, dust mopping the floor by pushing the mop on the floor, along the base of the wall.



WORK your way acro

your way across the room using overlapping mopping paths.



REMOVE

dust mop from the Quick-Connect frame, grasping the mop by the fabric loop and peeling away.



DEPOSIT soiled mop into the mesh laundry net.



OPEN lid by lifting the front tab.



PLACE first stack of mop pads into the Charging Bucket with the logo-imprinted side of the mop pads facing upward.



ADD first measurement of the water and/or cleaning solution to the Charging Bucket, pouring on top of the mop pads and moving back and forth to achieve even saturation.



PLACE
the remaining mop
pads in the Charging
Bucket making sure
that the logo-imprinted
sides of the mop pads
are facing upward.



ADD
the rest of the water
and/or cleaning solution
to the Charging Bucket,
pouring on top of the
mop pads and moving
back and forth.



SECURE lid to the Charging Bucket by snapping the front tab into place.



OPEN lid by lifting the front tab.



ATTACH
mop pad by aligning the
Quick-Connect frame
with the center of a mop
pad and press down
firmly until the mop pad
attaches to the frame.
Ensure the frame is fully
engaged before lifting.

STABLE SAFETY SIGN

NOTES

- Don all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): glasses, gloves, etc.
- Dust mop before wet mopping for optimal infection prevention and floor maintenance.
- The Charging Bucket is safe for use with all types of floor cleaning chemicals, including bleach, hydrogen peroxide, and d-Limonene based solutions.
- Properly charged mops hold enough solution to clean a standard-sized room - approximately 250 square feet. Use a clean wet mop for each room to help prevent cross-contamination.
- · Follow all established safety procedures.



PLACE Stable Safety Sign at the entrance to the room being cleaned.



AFFIX
Quick-Connect Handle to the
18" Quick-Connect Frame.



OPEN the Charging Bucket.



CENTER
Quick-Connect Frame over
the Charging Bucket and
push down to attach the
mop via hook-and-loop
connection. Close the lid.



BEGIN at the far corner of the room, mopping the floor using overlapping Figure 8 strokes, while moving backward toward the doorway. Remember to clean beneath beds and

furniture.



PULL the soiled mop from the frame and drop into the mesh laundry net.



REMOVE soiled mop by placing one foot on an exposed edge of the mop and the other foot on the end of the Quick-Connect Frame.



PULL
the handle upward and the
mop will peel away from the
Quick-Connect Frame.
NOTE: The soiled mop should
be removed from the frame
when finished mopping or

when mop is dry.



LIFT the soiled mop, using the Quick-Connect Frame, positioned at a 90° angle to the mop.

HIGH SECURITY CLEANING CART

NOTES

- Don all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): glasses, gloves, etc.
- Dust mop before wet mopping for optimal infection prevention and floor maintenance.
- Use High Absorbency Mop to clean larger areas. Replace the pad every time the Rubbermaid PULSE needs to be refilled.
- Use the Scrubber Mop on tile or stone floors.
- Follow all established safety procedures.



FILL Rubbermaid PULSE Caddy with cleaning solution.



PLACE
Rubbermaid PULSE Caddy
in the Rubbermaid* High
Security Cleaning Cart.



PLUG
the Rubbermaid PULSE
Caddy Clean Connect" hose
into the cap fitting to fill the
reservoir. Cleaning solution
will automatically stop
filling when full. Disconnect
Clean Connect hose when
finished.

NOTE: If air in the Rubbermaid PULSE reservoir impedes the flow of liquid, loosen the cap and perform a manual fill.




FOR MANUAL FILLING, open the red cap at the top of the Rubbermaid PULSE reservoir, fill the reservoir, and replace the cap.



PLACE Stable Safety Sign to alert pedestrians of the potential slip-and-fall hazard.



REMOVE soiled mop by placing one foot on an exposed edge of the mop and the other foot on the end of the Quick-Connect Frame. Pull the handle upward and the mop will peel away from the Quick-Connect Frame. NOTE: The soiled mop should be removed from the frame when finished mopping or when mop is dry.



AFFIX the wet mop to the Quick-Connect Frame.



LIFT the soiled mop, using the Quick-Connect Frame, positioned at a 90° angle to the mop.



START
in the far corner of the
room, pressing the red
trigger button on the
handle of the Rubbermaid
PULSE, dispensing enough
cleaning solution onto floor
to moisten the wet mop.



PULL the soiled mop from the frame and drop into the mesh laundry net.



MOP moving backwards, using Figure 8 strokes. As the mop becomes dry, press the trigger to dispense more cleaning solution.







FLEXIBLE DUSTING WAND WITH MICROFIBER SLEEVE



NOTES

- Don all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- Do not move locations with poles fully extended.
- Follow all established safety procedures; do not use near electrical wiring.



SELECT the appropriate length Quick-Connect Adjustable Handle or Pole for the task. Remember, the longer the handle, the heavier it will be.



SELECT the right dusting sleeve for the task. High Pile dust sleeves are ideal for dusting or wet cleaning.



BEND the Flexible Wand to the shape of surface being cleaned.



AFFIX
Flexible Wand to QuickConnect Extension
Handle or Pole.



EXTEND handle/pole to the desired length.



LOCK handle/pole by twisting the collar clockwise until tight.



DUST surface, keeping both hands on the handle/pole and both feet securely on the ground.



TWIST the collar counter-clockwise to retract the handle/pole when the task is complete.







11" MICROFIBER FLEXI-FRAME



MICROFIBER FLEXI-FRAME COVERS

AND POLES



NOTES

- Don all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- Do not move locations with poles fully extended.
- Specialized mop covers for all cleaning occasions:
- Wet: General wet mopping
- High Pile: Wet or dry dusting
- Glass: Glass and polished surfaces
- Tub and Tile: Tile, grout, and rough surfaces
- Low Pile: Dry dusting
- Follow all established safety procedures; do not use near electrical wiring.



SELECT the appropriate length Quick-Connect Adjustable Handle or Pole for the task. Remember, the longer the handle, the heavier it will be.



SELECT the right mop cover. High Pile cover is ideal for dusting or wet cleaning. Tub and Tile cover is best for shower cleaning.



AFFIX Flexi-Frame to Quick-Connect Extension Handle or Pole.



EXTEND handle/pole to the desired length.



LOCK handle/pole by twisting the collar clockwise until tight.



DUST hard-to-reach areas with High Pile mop cover.



SCRUB shower tile and grout with the Tub and Tile mop cover.



TWIST the collar counter-clockwise to retract the handle/pole when the task is complete.







NOTES

- Don all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- Color-coding can help prevent cross-contamination.
- Assign each color to a specific area and task:
- Yellow: Bathrooms
- Red: High-risk areas/beds
- Blue: Specialty Areas
- Green: General Purpose
- Light Blue: Glass Surfaces
- Do not over-saturate cloths.
- Follow all established safety procedures.



BEGIN with open, clean microfiber cloth.



FOLD microfiber cloth in half.



FOLD
microfiber cloth in
quarters, resulting in a
square-shaped pad with
four layers of cloth.



CLEAN
surfaces with the two
exposed sides of the
microfiber cloth. Track the
side used for each surface
while cleaning.



OPEN microfiber cloth once to change sides.



REFOLD to expose two fresh cleaning surfaces. Track the side used for each surface while cleaning.



OPEN the cloth fully once four surfaces have been used and expose four fresh surfaces.




REPEAT steps 2 through 7 to use all eight sides.

GETTING STARTED:









*Machine settings can be established by chemical provider.

THE FOLLOWING STEPS ARE RECOMMENDED TO PROPERLY LAUNDER AND TAKE CARE OF YOUR MICROFIBER:



CLEAN the laundry machines daily, before the first use.



SEPARATE soiled Rubbermaid HYGEN Microfiber Cloths and Mops from other textiles at the point of contamination.



DETERMINE detergent and maximum load size using chart on the right.*



For higher level of clean and added layer of assurance, use chlorine bleach, as applicable. Confirm with chemical supplier for correct quantity¹



WASH Rubbermaid HYGEN Microfiber Cloths and Mops using the step-by-step guide on the right.²



(Exact time/speed may vary depending on machine type and/or operating condition)



Pre-rinse/soak: Mops/cloths may require pre-rinses/soaks to open fibers and loosen soil

Washing with Cold Water: chlorine bleach is required, refer to measurements in prior step



Water Quality: Soft water (zero grains hardness); low to moderate alkalinity (0-100 ppm @Na2O); no iron in water



COMMERCIAL DRYING

- Dry cloths and mops on low heat (130°F/54°C) setting
- Remove dry textiles from the dryer immediately
- Store dry cloths and mops in clean Rubbermaid Cube Truck



REQUIRED CARE

- Do not store Rubbermaid HYGEN™ Cloths or Mops in a washing machine overnight
- Do not use fabric softener
- Do not use dryer sheets

*Machine settings can be established by chemical provider.
**Represents 1/2 the average manufacturer's detergent recommendation. Using full amount of detergent can result in hazy floors.

Always follow the protocol as directed by your facility manager. 'Follow manufacturer instructions for bleach use. 'Per CDC Guidelines for healthcare facilities.
